



FAMILIARISATION PROGRAMME FOR INDEPENDENT DIRECTORS OBJECTIVES

The Familiarisation programme is formulated with the objective of making the Independent Directors of the Company to understand:

FAMILIARISATION PROCESS

These meetings will provide an opportunity to the Independent Directors to interact with Executives of the company and help them to understand the organisation structure, business models, opportunities available to the company, Risk management, technology, human resources etc.,
