## CM Rekha inaugurates 51 new Ayushman Arogya Mandirs

Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Friday inaugurated 51 new Ayushman Arogya Mandirs from Fatehpur Beri village in South Delhi, taking the total number of such centres in the Capital to 370 in just eight months. She said the expansion marks a major step in strengthening Delhi's primary healthcare system and ensuring that every citizen has access to timely and affordable treatment.

Speaking at the event, the Chief Minister said healthcare is the Government's top priority. "Ayushman Arogya Mandirs are not merely treatment centres; they are hubs of prevention, awareness and

trust. When the intent is clear and the resolve is strong, results follow swiftly. Setting up 370 Arogya Mandirs within a year reflects our commitment," she said.

The programme was attended by South Delhi MP Ramvir Singh Bidhuri, Chhatrapur MLA Kartar Singh Tanwar, municipal councillor Sunder Singh Tanwar, senior officials and local residents. The Chief Minister inspected the newly inaugurated centre and reviewed the services being offered.

She checked whether essential diagnostic tests, medicines and treatment facilities were functioning properly and whether people were receiving timely care.

She said the Ayushman

Arogya Mandirs have brought a visible change in Delhi's healthcare system. These centres focus not only on treatment but also on preventive and promotive care. Each centre provides around 80 types of free diagnostic tests. Essential medicines are available at no cost. Facilities for advanced diagnostic services and cancer screening have also been introduced.

The centres also offer immunisation, maternal and child health services, elderly care and screening for non-communicable diseases. Dedicated rooms have been created for mothers and children. The infrastructure has been designed to be modern and patient-friendly.

The Chief Minister said the

initiative will reduce the burden on big hospitals. It will help cut long waiting times and ensure that people get treatment close to their homes. She added that the government plans to set up more than 1,000 Ayushman Arogya Mandirs in the coming years.

Later in the day, the Chief Minister launched development projects worth ₹322 crore in the Chhatrapur Assembly constituency.

She laid the foundation stone for works related to road construction and strengthening, drainage improvement, traffic-easing measures and school infrastructure upgrades. Public amenities in local colonies will also be improved.

The Chief Minister also announced that a double-decker flyover has been approved on the Mehrauli-Badarpur Road at a cost of ₹1,471 crore. She said the project will help reduce traffic congestion in the area.

Chhatrapur will get three new schools as part of the development push. Four elevated road projects have also been approved for Chhatrapur and nearby areas.

The Chief Minister said her Government sees healthcare and infrastructure as long-term investments in the city's future.

She said the goal is to build a system where quality healthcare and better civic facilities are available to all residents without difficulty.

## Govt issues cybersecurity advisory to departments

The Delhi Government has issued an advisory to its departments, asking them to strengthen cybersecurity measures and refrain from accessing anonymously shared links or attachments on office computers.

The advisory issued on Thursday by the Information Technology (IT) department of the Government asked all the heads of the departments to ensure that they also nominate an assistant chief information security officer on priority.

The safety of the IT infrastructure is most important, and any breach may give a



bad name to the Delhi Government, the advisory said, adding that all departments must ensure adoption of proactive steps to safeguard against any cyber incident.

All the websites or applications running in departments must possess valid security audit certificates, it said, and prohibited accessing anonymously shared links, websites or attachments on the office computers.

The advisory said only the National Informatics Centre (NIC) email should be used for official communication, and any third-party channel for official purposes must be avoided. It also directed that pirated software must not be used on office computers, and antivirus packages should be downloaded to thwart any glitch or cybersecurity breach.

Among the security measures recommended were shutting down computers while leaving the office, using strong passwords and multi-factor authentication for accessing sensitive data or information, and not sharing passwords with anyone.

The departments have also been advised to manage the inventory of IT infrastructure installed and backup data while also ensuring that the devices, operating systems and other installations are updated.

Previously, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) secretary had written to the states and Union territories to take immediate measures for enhancing cybersecurity.

According to the directions, the departments were to ensure MAC (media access control) binding to prevent unauthorised access, upgrade the operating system of all computers and devices to the latest version and remove obsolete equipment from the cyber network.

## Schools receive bomb threat emails

At least seven schools in Delhi received bomb threat emails on Friday morning, which were later declared a 'hoax'. The threatening email carried disturbing and provocative content, claiming, "Delhi will become Khalistan, and a bomb blast will happen at 1.11 pm in schools."

The email also claimed that a blast would take place inside Parliament at 2.11 pm, prompting heightened security alerts and coordination among multiple agencies.

The Delhi Fire Services (DFS) revealed the names of schools that received the threat email — Delhi Tamil



Education Association on Pusa Road, Kendriya Vidyalaya in Gole Market, Happy Public School in Daryaganj, Rabea Public School in Ballmaran, and CL Bhalla DAV School in Jhandewalan.

Police said that two other schools — Sardar Patel Vidyalaya in Lodhi Estate and British School in Chankyapuri — also received the threat emails.

According to DFS, the first call was received before 9.12

am, followed by others at 9.59 am, 11.07 am, 11.08 am, and 1.39 pm. In a message to parents, the SPV school said, "Dear Parents, this morning the school received a security threat. As a precautionary measure, the police are in school for necessary security measures. All students have been evacuated safely. Once the school is declared safe, classes will be resumed."

"We carried out thorough search operations and found nothing suspicious. The threat has been declared a 'hoax,'" the DFS said.

A similar incident occurred on Monday when more than a dozen schools received bomb threat emails, which also turned out to be a hoax.

## Punjab Govt to issue final reply in Atishi privilege case

Punjab's Additional Chief Secretary (Home) will issue a final reply in the privilege case involving Atishi, Delhi Leader of Opposition, after obtaining approval from the competent authority, officials said Friday.

The Delhi Assembly Secretariat had sought written comments from the Punjab Government in connection with a breach of privilege and contempt matter related to alleged remarks made by Atishi



concerning Sikh Gurus. In an official statement, the Office of the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Home Affairs, Government of Punjab, clarified that, prior to receiving the February 5 communication, there had been

no direct correspondence from the Delhi Legislative Assembly Secretariat regarding this specific case. The department stated that since receiving the February 5 document, it has actively processed the matter. It also confirmed that, afterward, formal comments from senior law enforcement and forensic authorities in Punjab were sent to the concerned offices in Delhi.

These include inputs from the Director General of Police (DGP), Punjab, the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, and the Director of

the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL), Punjab. The comments address the issues raised by the Delhi Legislative Assembly Secretariat.

Officials said a comprehensive and formal response from the additional chief secretary is now being finalised. The reply will present Punjab's definitive position on the matter. It incorporates the findings and reports submitted by the state's top police and forensic authorities. The draft response has been submitted for approval by the competent authority. Once cleared, it will be formally communicated to the Delhi Legislative Assembly Secretariat.

The case relates to alleged remarks attributed to Atishi, who is the Leader of the Opposition in the Delhi Legislative Assembly.

The Secretariat had sought the Punjab Government's views as part of its examination of the privilege and contempt issue. Punjab officials said the process is being handled as per established procedure. They added that the final reply will be sent after all required approvals are in place.

## Woman injured after jumping from hotel's 3rd floor in Farsh Bazar area

A 20-year-old woman was seriously injured after she jumped from the third floor of a hotel in East Delhi's Farsh Bazar area on Friday afternoon. The incident took place at Santosh Residency hotel on 60 Feet Road, a day before Valentine's Day.

Shahdara Deputy Commissioner of Police Prashant Gautam said police received a call around 1 pm



about a woman jumping from the hotel building. "When the police team reached the spot, it was found that a 20-year-old woman had jumped from

the hotel. She had checked in with a 22-year-old man. They had an argument in the room before the incident. She is undergoing treatment in the hospital," he said.

According to police, the woman is a resident of Sunder Nagri. The man is from Bulandshahr in Uttar Pradesh. Both had checked into the hotel earlier in the day and booked a room. Preliminary inquiry suggests that the two had a heated argument inside the room.
